<p><b>Training Pathways</b></p>	<p>Traineeship, Assessment only, Recognition of Prior Learning</p> <p>Upon completion of this qualification learners could progress to a Certificate IV in Community Services. Students may also take advantage of their learning to move into a pathway to higher or more specialised position or qualification in the Aged Care, Child Care, Youth Work, Health or Disability sectors</p>
<p><b>Duration of Training</b></p>	<p>A full-time Traineeship is contracted for an 18 month period and part-time Traineeships for 3 years. This information is provided at indenture and enrolment.</p> <p>Duration times for any fee-for-service courses or subsidised courses will be provided in pre-enrolment information and depend on the mode of delivery.</p> <p>The duration of the course will be sufficient to give every student the opportunity to learn the required skills and knowledge and complete the assessment tasks.</p>
<p><b>Delivery Mode</b></p>	<p>Employment Based – You complete the qualification whilst employed.</p>
<p><b>Eligibility</b></p>	<p>Eligibility requirements may apply for some government subsidised training programs.</p>
